



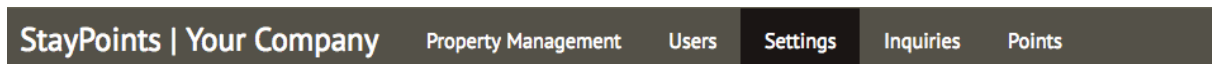

STEP 1: FINDING YOUR ACCOUNT INFORMATION

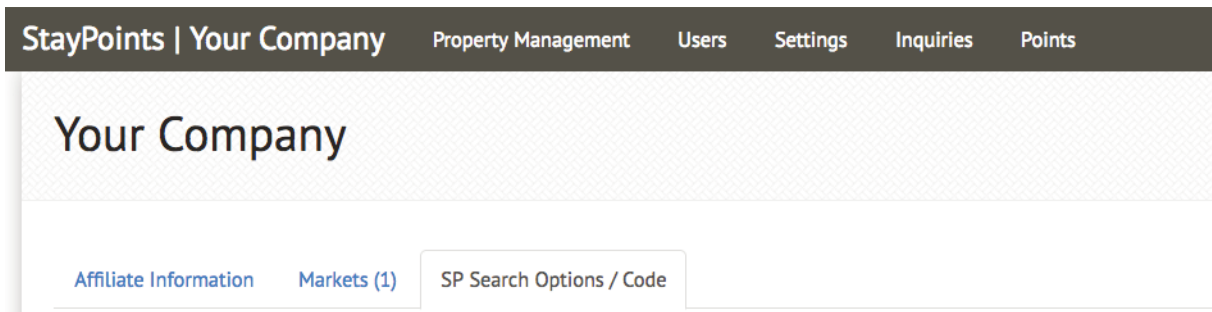
One of the first things that you, as an administrator, will need to do is identify your Affiliate ID. For Level 3 integration, you will also need to know how to find an individual property ID.

To find your Affiliate ID within your StayPoints account...

1. Log into your StayPoints account, and click on "Settings."



2. On the settings screen, select "SP Search Options/Code."



3. Scroll down to the "iframe example section." Example below shows where to find your Affiliate ID (highlighted in blue)

STEP 1: IFRAME SEARCH BOX TO YOUR WEBSITE

Adding a search box to your website to let your end users view your properties

The above search box is an iframe, meaning the content lives on a separate website and pulls into your website into an iframed window.

If you're using Wordpress, add a new page, then copy and paste the snippet of code (right) into the text editor. Make sure that you've selected the "text" mode on the top right of the text editor. Also, be sure to swap out the [Affiliate ID] for your identification number. If you're using a basic HTML website, you can place this iframe wherever you deem fit.

Below are a few settings that can be enabled or disabled to change the look, feel, and functionality of your SPSearch. You don't have to make any changes to the default settings, they are designed to give you some flexibility on how the search box integrates with the look and feel of your website. Any settings now explicitly demonstrated in the iframe are managed within SPSearch sub-tab on the Admin Dashboard.

iFrame Variables:

- text (Yes or No) - Shows or hides the logo that appears above the search box
- theme (Light or Dark) - Choose accordingly for dark or light themed websites
- type (Regular or Boxed) - Add a box around the search box if desired

Search Results:

- Just My Properties - Only show properties in the search result that are tagged or found under the "My Properties" sub-tab of the Property Management tab.
- All Relevant Properties - Show all properties in the system that are relevant to the end-user's search criteria

Search Result Location:

- New Window - The end-user's search results are opened in a new tab / window with the staypointsrewards.com
- In Current Frame - The end-user's search results will stay in the same frame as the search box
- New Page - The end-user's search results are opened in a new tab / window using the Redirect URL field (for example: <http://yoursite.com/search-results>)

Colors:

- There are a number of settings to control the text, border, button, and background color

Logo:

- Let's affiliate upload their logo to appear above the search text box

Options:

- Remove Header and Footer - Hides the header and footer from not showing on the results page or property page
- Remove Featured Properties - Hides the featured properties section that normally appears above the search results

RESULTS PAGE: SEARCH RESULTS POPULATE ON YOUR DOMAIN

Create a new page in your Wordpress website called "Search Results" and drop the snippet of code (right) in your page body using the same aforementioned text editor in "text" mode. This will ensure that when the user uses the search box from option 1, the results appear to be on your individual website, not on the Staypoints website.

```

Your URL should look something like the following example:

Example Page: [http://yoursite.com/search-results?companyId=\[Affiliate ID\]&q=birmingham&onlyShowForCompany=True](http://yoursite.com/search-results?companyId=[Affiliate ID]&q=birmingham&onlyShowForCompany=True)

You will need to swap out the [Affiliate ID] for the actual affiliate ID you started with in the beginning to see the desired URL

PROPERTY PAGE: INDIVIDUAL PROPERTY SEARCH RESULTS POPULATES TO AN DIRECT LINK ON YOUR DOMAIN

Create another new page in your Wordpress website called "Property Details" and drop the snippet of code (right) in your page body using the same aforementioned text editor in "text" mode.

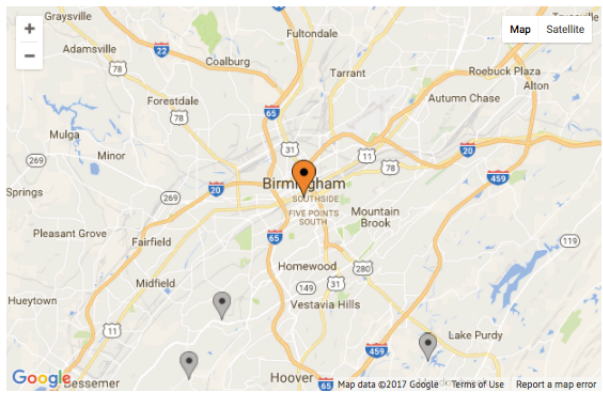

Your URL should look something like the following example:

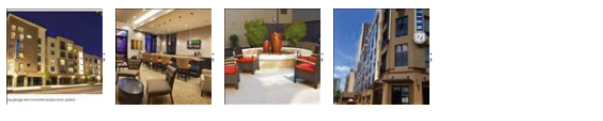
